Go Riteway Transportation Group Proposed Contract Amendment

The Transportation Committee met on Monday, June 26th to discuss a one-year contract extension with Go Riteway Transportation Group as well as a 1.9% rate increase over 2016-17 for the upcoming school year. Our base five-year contract is from 2013-18. With the annual one-year extensions granted, the contract if approved Monday, July 17th, would end June 30, 2022.

Enclosed with this memorandum, please find a rate comparison sheet, historical rate increase sheet, and the contract Addendum that Go Riteway has prepared following the Transportation Committee Meeting (and accompanying letter). We will increase the student transport days from 174 days to 175 for 5 year old kindergarten-Grade 12 next year.

A recommended motion would be "to move approval of the proposed rate adjustment and one year contract extension to the Go Riteway Transportation Company Contract (Amendment #4) as presented."

SCHOOL DISTRICT OF MILTON 2013-18 TRANSPORTATION CONTRACT 2017-18 AMENDMENT (#4)

The School District of Milton ("District") and Riteway Bus Service, Inc. dba GO Riteway Transportation Group ("Company") hereby agree to amend the contract as follows:

- The term of the contract shall be extended to include the 2021-22 school year.
- The rate increase for the 2017-18 school year shall be 1.9% and the rates will be as follows:

- The District and the Company hereby agree to amend the contract with the following verbiage as follows:
 - O The Company will supply, maintain and install Star seats or similar type seats in school buses if required by Special Education students IEPs (Individual Education Plans). If there is a specialized car seat/restraint/ harness or other transportation seat aide that is different than the Star seat or similar device that is required by the Special Education Students IEP, the District will provide the specifications to the Company. The Company will obtain, maintain and install the equipment for use in a school bus in transporting the student. The Company will submit a separate invoice to the District for the reimbursement of the required, Special Equipment.



- The last three sentences in Section II (C) are hereby deleted and are re-stated as follows; Should the District arrive at the decision to cancel school days, the District agrees to compensate the Company for the agreed upon number of school days according to the school calendar, regardless of whether there are cancellation days or not, for the number of vehicles it would customarily supply on such cancellations day(s).
- O The compensation language in Section VI (C) (1) is superseded by the following language; When daily bus routes are established in August, the Company shall calculate the cost for the school year for regular daily transportation, K4, and special education routes based on the agreed upon number of school days scheduled. Upon agreement by the District, the total cost shall be paid in 10 equal monthly installments beginning in August. Alterations in school transportation will be billed in a supplemental invoice each month.
