DIRECTIONS FOR INDIVIDUAL APPLICATIONS

(All scholarships that follow require individual applications)

- Individual scholarship applications are scholarships that are not a part of our standard scholarship application process. Each scholarship listed in this packet has a unique application that you need to either complete and turn in to Ms. Williams in Student Services or complete and turn in online or by email directly to the sponsor.
- Please read each scholarship's criteria carefully. Some scholarships will have web links where you can apply directly online for their scholarship, and other scholarships will have paper copies of their applications that you will pick up in the Student Services Center.
- All scholarships that state they need to be turned in to the Student Services Center must be turned in at 2:00 PM on the date listed in this packet.
- Some scholarship deadlines will be different than what is listed in the application. Please make sure you are using the deadline listed in this packet. Ms. Williams mails a lot of the applications on your behalf for the entire class. There is more time needed to review and mail applications and often sponsors want applications in hand on the date of their specific application. No late applications will be accepted.
- Some scholarships may require additional materials such as essays, letters of recommendation, a photograph, etc. Make sure you read each scholarship's criteria carefully.
- Ms. Williams in Student Services can help you get copies of your transcript or other school-related materials.

INDIVIDUAL SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATIONS

ELKS MOST VALUABLE STUDENT SCHOLARSHIP

AWARD: Varies

DEADLINE: November 12, 2024

Eligibility criteria:

1. Graduating senior who is planning to attend an accredited four- year post-secondary college or university.
2. Application selections are based on leadership, academic achievement and records, community involvement and financial need.

DAVE CZERWINSKI MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP

AWARD: Three of \$250

DEADLINE: January 21, 2025

Eligibility criteria:

1. Graduating senior who has enrolled in a certified college, university, or vocational school in degree program.
2. Graduating senior with participation in at least one extra-curricular activity
3. Graduating senior must have had employment for at least three months throughout their high school career.
4. **Application for this scholarship needs to be picked up in the Student Services Center.**
5. **Turn completed application to the Student Services Center once complete.**

MILTON BASKETBALL BOOSTERS SCHOLARSHIP

DEADLINE: JANUARY 21, 2025

AWARD: Undetermined of \$250

Eligibility criteria:

1. Graduating senior who has been a part of the MHS basketball team for all 4 years.
2. **Pick up in the Student Services Center.**
3. **Turn in completed application to the Student Services Center.**

MILTON AREA CHAMBER OF COMMERCE (MACC) SCHOLARSHIP

DEADLINE: JANUARY 30, 2025

AWARD: Three of \$500

Eligibility criteria:

1. Student who is a MACC member company owner, an employee of a MACC member company, the child of a MACC member company employee. List of all companies that are a part of the MACC can be found [here](#) .
2. Student is enrolled full time, either as a high school senior or as a college student or technical college student at the undergraduate level.
3. **Students will need to include the following items with the application: *Essay* (see application for more information), *one letter of recommendation* (recommended but not required), *resume, transcript* (Ms. Williams will include).**
4. **Pick up in the Student Services Center.**
5. **Turn in completed application to the Student Services Center.**

AMERICAN ASSOCIATION OF UNIVERSITY WOMEN SCHOLARSHIP

AWARD: One of \$1000

DEADLINE: February 1, 2025

Eligibility criteria:

1. Graduating senior who is planning to attend an accredited post-secondary college or university to earn an associate's degree or a bachelor's degree.
2. Recipients should plan to attend the AAUW meeting at 6:00 PM on May 27th.
